The following instructions are issued for conducting June-2022 Supplementary Examination.

1. The Time Table should be exhibited in the Notice Board of all the Nursing Schools well in time for the information of the students.
2. The eligibility criteria for promotion as per the orders of the Honourable High Court, Karnataka vide Writ petition No. 32695-32698/2013 (EDN-EX) dated 10-03-2014 is as follows.
3. A student can be promoted from 1st year to the 2nd year without passing all the subjects in 1st year. However, he / she cannot take the 3rd year examination without completing 1st and 2nd year examination.
 - i) A student failed in all the subjects in the 1st year is eligible to go to 2nd year classes.
 - ii) A student failed in all the subjects in the 1st and 2nd year is eligible to go to 3rd year classes only

This procedure is adopted from February 2015 GNM examination and onwards.

Hence, the applications should be properly scrutinized and the applications of eligible students should only be uploaded. The applications can be uploaded from 11-05-2022 to 25-05-2022.

• The fees paid once will not be refunded or adjusted to any other fees.

4. The Examination fee should be paid through SBI E-payment Option Only.

*** NEFT, RTGS, Cheques, DD's & other mode of payment will not be accepted and will be strictly rejected.**

For 1st, 2nd & 3rd Year Fresh students fees structure is as follows.

First Year 05 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.1,500/-

Second Year 07 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.2,100/-

Third Year 04 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.1,200/-

For repeaters the examination fees is Rs.300/- per Subject (Theory & Practical Separate)

5. All the Principals are informed to issue School ID Badge to all the students for their Identity and they are directed to wear the same during the examination, and also the students and faculty members should be directed to wear white uniform photos during the examination.
6. For academic clarification the Principal or Senior Nursing Tutors should only come to the Examination Board.
7. The Internal assessment marks for each Theory paper is 25 marks. The students should score a minimum of 13 marks to pass. Similarly, the Internal Assessment marks for practical is 50 marks. The students should score a minimum of 25 marks to pass. The exam applications of the students those who have not scored the minimum marks in Internal Assessment should not be sent to the Board. **Internal Assessment Score Sheets for Theory and Practical for all the 1st, 2nd & 3rd year students and Mental Health Nursing score sheet should be uploaded online only. Date of availability to upload will be intimated in due course.**
8. The students should have attended 80% of Theory & Practical classes to appear for the annual Examination.
9. External Practical Marks should be uploaded immediately after the completion of each practical examination session wise.

The Principals are requested to furnish the Institution E-mail I.D. if not given already and if there are any changes, fresh E-mail I.D. should be informed immediately to KSDNEB.
